NITA IS AN ARTIST AND EDUCATOR. Her work explores intersections – among art and science, creativity and entrepreneurship, technology and humanity, teaching and learning. She presents her ideas through live performance, in exhibition spaces, and online and is included in Stephen Wilson's book, Information Arts (MIT Press, 2001). In 2003, Nita directed the award-winning "Invisible Ideas" project – the first Flash-enabled, GPS-triggered interactive art walk. She has taught courses combining art, technology and science at several institutions, including Carnegie Mellon and Harvard University, for more than 15 years. Nita is currently Associate Professor and Department Chair in the Studio for Interrelated Media at Massachusetts College of Art.
